**FINAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

After considering Plaintiff DIRECTV, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment Against Defendant Clifford G. Jones (the "Motion") and supporting evidence, any response, and all other evidence on file, the Court finds that the Motion has merit and there are no genuine issues of material fact. It is, therefore,

**ORDERED** that the Motion be, and is hereby, **GRANTED**. It is further

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that Plaintiff have and recover judgment from Defendant Clifford G. Jones, also known as Cliff Jones, for the following:

1. \$1,220,000.00 for Defendant's one hundred twenty-two violations of 47 U.S.C §605; one hundred twenty-two violations of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2511; and one hundred twenty-two violations of Chapter 123, of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code resulting from Defendant's actual use of at least one signal theft device, and Defendant's sale or distribution of at least one hundred twenty-one signal theft devices;
2. Reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees and expenses in the amount of \$4,800.00;
3. Conditional awards for attorneys' fees and expenses of an additional \$5,000 if an appeal is made to the Texas Court of Appeals, plus an additional \$2,500 if a petition for review is made to the Texas Supreme Court, plus an additional \$5,000 if a petition for review is granted by the Texas Supreme Court; and


4. Post-judgment interest on all of the foregoing amounts at the federal statutory rate from the date of this judgment until paid.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that Defendant Clifford G. Jones, as well as any person acting on his behalf, is permanently enjoined from committing or assisting in the commission of any violation of 47 U.S.C. § 605, 18 U.S.C. § 2511 and Chapter 123 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.

All writs and processes for the enforcement and collection of this judgment against Defendant Clifford G. Jones shall issue as necessary.

All relief not expressly granted herein is denied.
