FINAL JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court following trial of the claims set forth in Plaintiff's Complaint, and the Court having rendered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby:


ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Defendant, OSMAR ESCALONA, is permanently enjoined from receiving, assisting in receiving, transmitting, assisting in transmitting, divulging or publishing direct television satellite transmissions in violation of 47 U.S.C. § 605 or 18 U.S.C. § 2511(1)(a).

Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff DIRECTV, INC., and against Defendant OSMAR ESCALONA, on the Complaint in the principal sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00).

This Court reserves jurisdiction to determine the amount of costs and fees, if any, which may be awarded to DIRECTV, INC. upon its filing of an appropriate motion.

All pending motions are DENIED AS MOOT, and this case is CLOSED.
